The Planning Officer asked Members for suggestions for the name of the private drive off Hatfield Road. Background research had identified two names of people who had assisted the Town Council in years gone by and the Chairman suggested that names related to Bridge Hospital might be appropriate and would therefore make enquiries. It was agreed that Hancock, Pitchforth and if possible additional names from Bridge Hospital be recommended to Braintree District Council.

### 6 Orchards, Witham

Proposed single storey rear extension with balcony

Councillor P. Barlow had declared an interest and left the Council Chamber.

Councillor J.C. Coleman then assumed the Chair.

Members noted that the proposed large extension would extend 5m into the garden across the back of the house but would narrow because of the shape of the garden. It was suggested that the size of the extension in relation to the footprint of the original dwelling would be over development. There was concern that the extension would have a flat roof used as a balcony and the plans showed an obscured screen height of just 1.5m on each side and across part of the back to retain privacy of neighbours.

After much discussion Members agreed that the application should be recommended for refusal on the grounds of overdevelopment of site and potential for adverse impact on neighbouring amenities.
